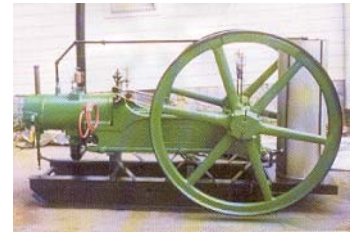

**Attention Farmall tractor owners:** You can receive a new tall vented gas cap for your tractor, if the serial number has not already been registered with NAVISTAR (the last remaining division of International Harvester. Go to the web site <http://www.ihgascap.com/index.aspx> and check for the models covered under the program, (it covers all the letter series tractors and numerous other models, but no diesel models), enter your name and serial numbers for your tractors and they will mail you, ABSOLUTELY FREE, a new gas cap for each tractor serial number entered. I know this looks too good to be true, but I today got 6 new gas caps in the mail, just 8 days after I entered my numbers.
